

International Football Camps Limited (IFC)

-Terms and Conditions of Juventus Camps 2017

-What is Included.

1. Only parents or legal guardians over the age of 18 can register their children for the camps.
2. The ages for the children are set between the ages of 7 years to 17 years.
3. Dates: Monday 9th October 2017 to Friday 13th October 2017.
4. Venue: The camp will be held at the Marist Sports Club and Arena Manawatu, Palmerston North. See the attached link for further detail <http://www.arenamanawatu.co.nz>
5. REGISTRATION: A formal registration process will be held on Sunday 8th October 2017. The details and times will be sent well in advance.
6. Times: This has not been set at this stage, but as a guideline, breakfast will be approximately around 9am with clinics starting around 9.30am after debrief and day plan. Clinics are expected to run from 10am to 4pm, with 2 hours for lunch.
7. The parents or legal guardians agree to these terms and conditions in full. Completion of registration is deemed to be acceptance of these terms and conditions, howsoever the registration process is completed.
8. Accommodation: This will need to be applied for separately at a later date. We are working with PNBHS College House for accommodation and hope to provide this as an additional option for players coming from out of town. Accommodation costs (if accommodation can be arranged via IFC) will be in addition to the registration fees, and otherwise all accommodation arrangements will be for the participants to arrange.
9. You can only register one player per registration. If there are multiple players to register, then a separate registration is required for each player.
10. All participants are required to provide a medical certificate to ensure that they are fit to participate at the five day camp. Note this is Juventus Football Club requirement.
11. A medical form will be sent out to all registrants which will contain sections for those who require specific dietary foods. This will need to accompany the medical certificate and will need to be returned within the timeframe required by IFC (to be detailed in the relevant form).
12. Selection of teams:
 - a. Juventus coaching staff will use their own selection criteria based on:
 - i. Age
 - ii. Ability
 - b. Groups of players who attend from teams. We may favourably consider grouping friends or players who have played in the same team. You will need to email, registration@ifc.nz with your request, to be decided at the sole discretion of IFC.
13. Participants are responsible for their own insurance arrangements and as such IFC is not responsible for any loss or damage of items of participants, or any loss or damage to items caused by participants. Any damage caused by participants to items or property will be made good by the participants at their own cost.
14. The Juventus October 2017 course will include the following:
 - a. The training camp fee without accommodation

- i. New Registrants: \$795.00 plus GST;
 - ii. Previous attendees to the IFC camps: \$695.00 plus GST; and
 - iii. Marist registrants: \$650.00 plus GST.
 - b. Meals will be made available at an additional cost, which costs will be detailed soon. For clarity, participants will need to make alternative arrangements for meals if not purchased from IFC.
 - c. Medical assistance will be available during training sessions. Should a doctor be called in case of illness, such costs will not be covered by IFC and will be met by the participant. Any injury related costs will be covered by ACC, but to the extent that ACC cover is not available, will be met by the participant.
 - d. One authentic Adidas Kit, comprising of a shirt, shorts and socks. Other items may soon be able to be purchased via our online portal
 - e. Training and technical education from staff selected from the Juventus FC youth projects
 - f. 1: 12 ratio of coaches to participants
 - g. Certificate of attendance
15. All participants are required to follow all rules and codes of conduct of Juventus, the Marist Club and IFC. Each will reserve the right to remove participants who are in breach of the rules or codes of conduct, and IFC has no responsibility for ensuring participants comply with the rules or codes of conduct. All participants registered will be accountable for their own behaviour and conduct.
16. Any abuse, whether verbal or physical against members of the public, staff, coaches or fellow participants will be treated with zero tolerance and will result in immediate removal of the participant from the course or clinics.
17. By registering, you will be added to the IFC and Marist database for all future correspondence, and you agree to receive such correspondence. Your information will be treated confidentially and not passed onto any third party without your prior consent. However, you acknowledge that Juventus will be provided with all relevant information of the participants, and may add the participant to its database also, and you consent to such disclosure.
18. Participants agree to their images (such as photographs taken during the camps) or their testimonials of the camps being used for future promotional purposes of Juventus, Marist and IFC.
19. IFC reserves the right to refuse applications from persons we feel that may jeopardise the integrity of the courses and clinics, or who may not meet the required skill threshold of Juventus, at its sole discretion. IFC also reserves the right to remove disruptive or abusive participants during the camps, at its sole discretion. IFC will not be held financially liable in the circumstances where a child is removed from the clinics.
20. Refund Policy:
- a. The participants acknowledge that the IFC will not issue refunds once IFC have paid for and ordered the kits. This is expected to be 30 June 2017.
 - b. A partial refund may be granted in some circumstances at the sole discretion of IFC management if there are legitimate and unforeseen reasons. Such refunds will be limited to a maximum refund of \$NZD115.00.
 - c. All requests for a refund must be made in writing and supporting evidence of the need for a refund may be required.
 - d. Participants acknowledge that IFC and Marist FC will incur costs that are non-refundable to it for each registration, and any refund that is given by IFC will take into account the costs it has incurred.
 - e. In the event a participant makes a part payment of the registration fees, but fails to make full payment of the registration fee by the required dates, the part payment will be forfeited to IFC. Late payments may jeopardise the position of the participant in the camps, and payments received after the specified payment dates may be accepted in the sole discretion of IFC.

21. These terms and conditions may be varied from time to time at the discretion of IFC. The varied terms and conditions will be published on the IFC website, and will bind participants from the date of variation.
22. These terms and conditions are only applicable to those aspects of the camps run or arranged by IFC and as such IFC does not take responsibility for the terms and conditions of other agencies IFC or participants may contract.
23. All purchases that are made in New Zealand will include GST and will be payable in NZ Dollars. Goods and services obtained from overseas must be paid in the local currency and can be made via our Credit Card facility. Tax invoices are available on request.
24. Payments will be via direct bank deposit or using our Credit Card options. All Credit Card payments will attract a commission of 3.5%
